We are starting our last quarter of the school year. That is so hard to believe. The children are definitely learning, growing and sharing so much of what they know. They are making connections to things we have learned previously to things that are currently happening which means they really have grasped the ideas. We love watching the "light bulb" moments when things really click for the children.

We talk a lot with the children about being helpers in their classroom and in their world. We want our children to know that each are an important part of how their classroom, family, community, etc. work. We practice this by making sure children help in clean up time after centers, help teachers with classroom jobs, help friends when they are struggling and many other ways. We talk about everyone working as a team to accomplish different goals and then celebrate or praise them as a group as well.

Earth Day is April 22 this year. This is a wonderful opportunity to do something as a family to help our Earth. It could be as simple as walking around your neighborhood picking up trash that is lying around. (Please make sure to use plastic gloves or use a "grabber" to keep yourself

and your child safe.)

Happy Spring from the Blue Room! We enjoyed the month of March a lot! We loved our pizza party, leprechaun hunting, and building traps for the leprechauns! We also had so much fun with our Easter Party and egg hunt! This month's themes are Spring, Insects/Bugs, and Eric Carle. We will be learning about story sequencing, and reviewing patterns, rhyming, and shapes, as well as taking nature walks. We will also be working on first and last names spelling and recognition. We will review letters A-T and continue on with our alphabet and continue practicing our cutting skills. We will also be working on numbers 11-20 (recognition).

At home you can reinforce the skills the children are learning by making shopping lists together and then having them find the letters at the store. You can always practice counting the items and reading the aisle numbers. For more letter identification practice you can get a magnifying glass and have your child look through the newspaper or a magazine to find the letters in their name. Have them highlight the letters they find. To help build fine motor skills and strength have your children play with playdough and even have them use laydough scissors to cut the playdough. They can also use children's scissors to cut thicker materials such as cereal boxes.

We are so excited for the Art Show on the 19th and hope you all can join us!

We hope you all enjoyed a healthy and fun Easter break. The Green Room friends really enjoyed learning the Easter Story from the Bible.

On Friday, April 19th the WEE Center will be hosting our annual Art Show, Chair Raffle, and Book Fair. There will be tasty treats available for purchase as well. We hope you can join us!

The Green Room friends will be learning about the following themes in April: The Plant Cycle, Gardens, and Earth Day, Baby Animals and the Types of Animals: mammals, amphibians, reptiles and birds, and Eric Carle Books.

SKILLS that we will work on: We will learn sight words using Readers and we will practice writing letters and numbers. We will review upper and lower case letters and their sounds. We will focus on basic sentence structure. We will spend more time on reading comprehension by recalling story events, identifying the characters, and making predictions.

For math, we will focus on two digit numbers and how we see them on ten frames. We will also use math sets to understand "more and less", and "equal". And, we will continue to work on simple addition. Thank you so much for your support! We love teaching your children.

Happy April/Happy Spring Purple Room Families,

Spring has finally arrived, and we're hopeful that warmer temperatures are going to be here to stay permanently! During April we will be learning about the letters Rr, Ss, Uu, and Jj. Math skills will be reviewing the ABBC pattern, moving forward with our ABCC pattern, and improving counting by 5's, and a bit more practice with skip counting (counting by 2's). We will also be comparing tall/short, long/short, and take a look at 3D shapes.

Our themed units in April with include Spring, Earth Day, Reduce/Reuse/Recycle, and perhaps the beginning of the Space unit. We will begin the month using the same prayers and patriotic song we did in March, but may change up about ½ way through the month. The door tags will remain home addresses, but will no longer have names on the back. Please review this information with your child and show them your house numbers on your home and point out your street sign as well. This will help bring relevance to him/her.

We hope to carve some time into our day to begin enjoying reading aloud a chapter book. Homework will continue coming home on Wednesdays (return by Monday), and our reading booklets will begin in April as well. These are for exposure to both sight words and words used often in stories/books.

Our WEE art show and chair raffle is on Friday, 4/19 from 6-7:30 p.m. We hope to see you there!

Finally, we hope everyone enjoyed the Easter break and are feeling renewed and ready to embark on our last chunk of the school year (unbelievable). We are looking forward to spending the next few months with your kiddos!
